"Our church, even though small, supported APC. It has always broken my heart to think about all the babies who have been sacrificed to abortion. I have always felt my ministry was with children. I taught kids Sunday School and Vacation Bible School and loved sharing God's Word and love with the children. Now that I'm retired, I knew I wanted to use my free time in a ministry that I am so passionate about -- the right to life of every unborn child. It is a privilege." -Sue Brady

"The first experience learning about APC was at a banquet and APC asked area churches to volunteer with setting up Mom2Mom, serving in the food line, and helping mothers with babies/children. That night at Mom2Mom I was with a mom of twins. My heart was captured by seeing firsthand the ministry to families. Later our church was presented the need for childcare for the Mom2Mom group and I had a tug in my heart that perhaps it was an opportunity to be involved in a small way on a regular basis. Especially in childcare, I saw an opportunity to help give moms a chance to get respite, even for just the 2 hours during Mom2Mom, knowing their baby or child(ren) are close by and playing, plus benefiting from being amongst a group of other moms. I love the babies and children and the friendships I've made with the other moms, volunteers and mothers of the children in childcare.

God opened a door for Wayne (my husband) to be involved in Dad2Dad group and with my involvement with childcare in Mom2Mom, it's been a really rewarding experience to us as a couple to be involved. It's something we can both be part of and feel like we're growing together by the inspiration the other moms and dads are to us. 


