in Evangelism

"Do you know how to discern the appearance of the sky, but cannot discern the signs of the times?" Matthew 16:3 NASB

Jesus, during His sojourn on earth, asked the religious leaders of Israel this question. Moving forward to today, we might ask ourselves, "Have I ever spent any time trying to discern the signs of the times as a Christian?"

I want to attempt to do so from the perspective of an evangelist, considering the world in which we live and how best to be about our Father's business of seeking and saving the lost.

I approach this discernment from a very personal standpoint. I have two sons who are growing into leaders of the Lord's church. How will I model and communicate this responsibility to them? The picture below provides an image of one important truth that I want my sons to realize. There is a ditch on both sides of the road. The only safe path is on the road.



This world is enamored with extremes and outrage. In the life of Christians and the church, many are being drawn into one ditch or the other, when we would be better served by considering a goal of aiming for Biblical center. Rather than reacting with outrage at extremes—and perhaps ending up in the opposite ditch—we would be wise to remember that God has provided His inspired Word to guide us in the straight and narrow way. His way should be our objective.

Since returning to the United States, I have heard many Christians react against their experience of "legalism" in their earlier life in the Lord's church. I'm truly sorry for their experience and would encourage them with the fact that adding man-made rules and binding them on others (the right ditch) is not from our Lord, but from man (Matthew 23:4). I also encourage them to resist jumping into the opposite ditch in outrage where the authority of Jesus and His apostles is thrown out with the "bath water" (the left ditch).

In the September 1969 issue of Action, Jimmie

Lovell and Reuel Lemmons were trying to discern their times for evangelism and seemed to be struggling most with the "right ditch". But what about today?

This brings me to my first discernment for evangelism. The question needs to be considered: Which ditch is the majority of our world (and our nation) struggling with? Though some Christians may have had a negative experience with the "right ditch", by far, our world and nation is awash with the spirit of license "to do what each one wants" rather than allow the authority of Jesus to guide one's life!

What does this mean for evangelism? The church must resist the cultural inertia of jumping into the left ditch of permissiveness and pursue relentlessly the path of Jesus as our King who has all authority. Our public and evangelism messages need to communicate the freedom and joy that comes in surrendering to the rule of the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus (Romans



8:1-3). The grace and forgiveness "in Christ" is provided for those who submit willingly to the rule of Christ in their life. This is discipleship.

If we allow ourselves to be driven by the currents of lawless culture in our

approach to salvation, worship, the organization of the church, our roles within the church and our morality, we cannot expect to be recognizable as the Lord's church. Our evangelism message and our walk with Jesus needs to be aligned for a world seeking an authentic relationship with Jesus and His church.

Our next generation is highly distrustful of "religion". The popular philosophy of relativism – where everyone has their "personal truth" – has created a generation who sees inconsistency as hypocrisy. This next generation is becoming weary of standing in intellectual quicksand. They are looking for a rock on which to stand. Let's introduce them to the rock known as Jesus (1 Cor. 10:4).

My second discernment for evangelism is related to the first. As a missionary, I am used to discovering how to communicate the Gospel in the "heart language" of the community in which I serve. Often this entails finding the "heart words" that accurately convey the teachings of Jesus and motivates the hearer to follow Him.

Sometimes we are tempted to get this process

confused with compromising the message to make it easier for the hearer to accept. Heartlanguage communication should never lead to a compromised message. We are ambassadors of a King entrusted with the Divine Word. We must faithfully deliver it (2 Cor. 5:20).

Toward this end, one of the most influential Biblical principles in my life has been that of the Restoration Plea. I'm not talking about an event in history, although it has certainly sparked those. Rather, I am talking about the Biblical principle of striving to grow into the ideal of the Christian life and of the Lord's Church and mission as revealed in Holy Scripture. This is the Restoration Plea taught in the Bible (2 Cor. 13:8-14 ESV). I want my two sons to discover the "heart words" of this beautiful and simple thought for their generation!

Every leader of World Bible School has discerned this Biblical principle for their time. Jimmie Lovell (Action, Aug 1962), Reuel Lemmons (Action, Sept 1984), Tex Williams (Action, Oct 1994), and John Reese (Action!, July 2017) have compellingly promoted the Restoration Plea in Action! Magazine.

Personally, I can not imagine NOT having the beauty of simple, New Testament Christianity as my aspiration. Yes, it is a Christian aspiration that is easier said than done, but so worthwhile. Settling for less just leads to earthly religion for which I am not willing to expend my life.

My third discernment for evangelism in our time is the very purpose for which WBS began: to motivate and equip a global network of Christians to use interactive Bible studies effectively. As Jimmie Lovell used to say, "We must become people of ACTION!" Over the last 50 years, we have been blessed with incredible evangelism tools that will teach us to teach, will pair us with a seeker asking for Bible study, will teach in a way that reaches even those who know nothing about God or His Word, with sensitivity and love and will help pursue Follow-up as we network with evangelists around the world.



Discerning Methods

of Success

As we celebrate 50 Forward, you have seen the astounding figures—conservatively, some 40 million worldwide have received World Bible School lessons. Many thousands have responded to the Gospel. In nation after nation, many of today's leaders first came to know Christ and His church through WBS. What is the secret of World Bible School's success?

Paul spoke of evangelism in these terms: "I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth" (1 Corinthians 3:6). The increase comes from God and rebounds to His glory. Yes, He works through humans, but they are not "anything," just "jars of clay" (1 Corinthians 3:7; 2 Corinthians 4:7). The power is not in us. Rather, God placed His divine power into the seed that is planted and watered.

Whatever our evangelistic methods, the only seed of success is the living Word of God with its kernel the Gospel (Luke 8:11; 1 Peter 1:23-25; Romans 1:16). That truth explains the success of WBS. WBS courses direct the Student to focus on the Scriptures—often printed in our booklets in red for visual emphasis. God's Word does the teaching. Course after course presents the Gospel and offers

its invitation. The seed germinates in receptive hearts that yield multiplied harvests.

The WBS difference is how much seed is sown and where. Seed carries life. But, powerful as is the potential, nothing happens while the seed remains in a bag on a shelf. It must be distributed. To sow on a small patch of ground is to assure a small harvest. If the seed is spread abundantly, covering much land, the harvest is greater. Following this principle, WBS mobilizes thousands of seed sowers. They cast so broadly that the good soil becomes evident. That is, the most receptive regions of the world respond well, which attracts more sowing and even greater harvests. That does not imply neglect for other regions. WBS Students are found in virtually every nation on earth. Often, when the first missionaries arrive in new or difficult areas, converts already reached through distance learning are assembled as the first congregations.

God works through seed sowers like WBS teachers. He also works through His servants who water and nurture for greater fruitfulness. We call this Follow-up. Over a 50-year history, WBS has built up many partnerships and networks of Christians who help with Student recruitment and Follow-up. In our new method of Ocean Bridge, we seek to improve lesson turnaround and thus Student retention. With your help, we are in the beginning stages of learning how to best pursue Follow-up for these Students.

The ultimate partnership is with God Himself. In the case of WBS, He has positioned it for even greater fruitfulness in the years ahead. He provides the workers and the means for wider, more efficient distribution of the Gospel seed. This is God's mission. He directs it. He empowers His saving seed. These truths assure us that the first 50 years are the first fruits that herald even greater harvests ahead!

God has been blessing WBS Students and Study Helpers through the efforts of Ocean Bridge. We continue to see stunning turnaround of graded lessons and the next courses delivered. Some recruiting areas are warming up and have not reached their full potential, but they are heading in the right direction.

In correlation, we also see a greater number of requests for baptisms. Because of this increase in Follow-up need, we have dispatched WBS representatives in various Ocean Bridge countries to address questions, create additional networking connections and implement plans of action.

Ron Pottberg, our most experienced international staff member and Godwin Isaac, our coordinator for Nigeria, traveled to Accra, Ghana. They worked together with our Ghana Ocean Bridge Service Center to collaborate on recruitment strategies, logistics and processes.

Brian and Sondra Davis traveled to Lagos, Nigeria, to meet with the Essien School of Preaching—a school affiliated with Sunset International Bible Institute—to coordinate Student recruitment and Follow-up with them. During this visit an entirely new office in Uyo was officially opened. Brian also spoke at the Great Workshop conference of over 600 church leaders who wanted to know how to help Follow-up with Ocean Bridge Students and plug new converts into their congregations. Brian and Sondra, along with 25 WBS Study Helpers, have been pursuing the same goals in Zambia and Zimbabwe.

Phil and Elaine Palmer, long-time missionaries to East Africa, were sent to Kenya to meet with leaders, school administrations and Students requesting baptism. Certain schools do not allow us to baptize at their facilities, but Phil found good cooperation with school administrators, allowing him to contact Students and their families to

organize Follow-up meetings. Phil and company patiently taught and introduced the Students to local evangelists of the churches of Christ and assisted in baptism when appropriate.

As Ocean Bridge is a new system, we spent most of our initial efforts making the recruiting and teaching system work, with more improvements coming later this year. Now, we are urgently working on getting Follow-up systems to work well and developing a mutual communication process by which churches and Study Helpers can get timely feedback on how the Follow-ups are going.

Jevin and his wife in Namibia



Discerning Those Who Have

Falen Away


Our mission at World Bible School is to share Jesus with the world by motivating and equipping a global network of Christians to use interactive Bible studies effectively.

Discerning the Fallen

In the Parable of the Sower, Jesus compares hearing the Word of God with a Sower who plants seed in various soils (Matthew 13, Mark 4, Luke 8). Jesus describes good fertile soil as one who understands the Word, accepts it and bears fruit. Yet Jesus also teaches of three other soils (or hearts), which do not bear fruit. The path refers to one who does not understand or believe. The rocky ground illustrates someone who falls away after facing tribulation or persecution. The soil with thorns describes someone who proves unfruitful due to seeking the riches, desires and cares of this world over God.

Do you know anyone who left their faith in Christ because of false teaching, a misunderstanding of God's Word or simply did not believe in Christ or His promises? You might know others who initially believed the message of Christ, but when faced with trials and struggles they lost their faith. We also commonly see brothers and sisters who leave Christ because they chose to prioritize the things of this world over their relationship with God.

Reaching the Fallen

When reaching the fallen, it's best to remember the first and greatest commandments: to love God and love your neighbor (Matthew 22:37-39). You who are spiritual should restore the fallen in a spirit of gentleness, speaking the truth in love (Galatians 6:1, Ephesians 4:14). If we love God, we will also love our fallen brothers or sisters as God does (1 John 4:7-21). We must remember love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never ends (1 Corinthians 13:4-8).

As we show love, our main objective should be to gain back our brother so their spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord (Matthew 18:15, 1 Corinthians 5:5).

To those who sin against us, Jesus commands us to go and tell him his faults between you and him alone. If they refuse to repent, take one or two others with you and if they continue to refuse repentance tell it to the church. If they continue to reject you and the church, the person is to be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector (Matthew 18:15-20).

But pause for a minute. Have you ever noticed in Matthew 18 and Luke 15, Matthew chooses to share Jesus' Parable of the Lost Sheep right before Jesus' instructions we just read regarding those who sin against us, but Luke chose to share the parable immediately after the Pharisees complained Jesus was eating with tax collectors and sinners? At the end of The Lost Sheep, Jesus says, "There will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance" (Luke 15:7). Jesus lovingly sought sinners and tax

collectors to repent like a shepherd seeking his lost sheep. He would go to their house, eat with them and encourage them to repent in hopes they would choose to enter into a new relationship with Him. For those who sin against us, we should seek to restore our relationship with them, just as Jesus did.

What about those who do not sin against us directly, but simply leave the faith? My brothers, if anyone among you wanders from the truth and someone brings him back, let him know that whoever brings back a sinner from his wandering will save his soul from death and will cover a multitude of sins (James 5:19-20). Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness (Galatians 6:1). When seeking the fallen, show the same love and earnesty of Jesus and the shepherd in compassion and gentleness.

In the Corinthian church, Paul addressed a brother practicing sexual immorality that was not tolerated even among the pagans. What's worse, the church was approving of his actions. Therefore, Paul wrote, "do not associate with anyone who bears the name of brother, who is guilty of sexual immorality or greed, or is an idolater, reviler, drunkard, or swindler" (1 Corinthians 5:1, 9-11).

It's important to remove or purge any unrepentant evil from inside the church (1 Corinthians 5:2, 12). But this does not mean we treat them as an enemy, but warn them as a brother (2 Thessalonians 3:15). The practice of disfellowship is not intended to be final punishment or justice. Vengeance is mine, I will repay says the Lord (Romans 12:19). Rather, we are to encourage the guilty party to recognize their sins and repent (1 Corinthians 5:5, 12-13). If they seek restoration, we must turn to forgive and comfort him, or he may be overwhelmed by excessive sorrow. So I beg you to reaffirm your love for him (2 Corinthians 2:7-8).

God also calls us to pray. If anyone sees his brother committing a sin not leading to death, he shall ask, and God will give him life (1 John 5:16). And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working (James 5:15-16).

Would a Christian feel comfortable confessing their sins to you? To follow God's command to pray, we must show proper love to our Christian family so they can share their struggles with us. When we confess our sins, not only can we receive forgiveness, it can also help prevent us from falling away.

As we seek to reach those who have fallen away let us 1) conduct ourselves in love and gentleness, 2) seek the fallen earnestly, 3) warn them as a brother and 4) pray, confessing our sins to one another. Let us show the same mercy, grace, slowness of anger, steadfast love and forgiveness which our Father in Heaven also extends to us (Exodus 34:6-7).

With the support of numerous congregations and individuals, we have developed a solution called Ocean Bridge, which is now operational in seven countries, soon to be nine. This new way of teaching allows WBS Coordinators to digitally scan and send graded lessons to WBS. We have tailored systems in each country, partnering with preachers, schools of preaching, prisons and secondary schools to deliver lessons to Students. This leads to productive teaching with fast turn around and high retention rates, increasing the likelihood of Students obeying the Gospel. Read more about Ocean Bridge on page 7.

Mathetis

Mathetis is dedicated to providing interactive Bible courses for group study online by combining high-quality video content with engaging lessons. This unique platform fosters a safe, online environment

where participants of all ages can deepen their faith and knowledge together.

One common concern, especially from parents and grandparents, is whether we offer lessons that address young people who have wandered away from their faith and can help them find their way back home. We understand the importance of this issue and are committing to developing a new Mathetis course and Bible class curriculum to help share compelling ways of asking those who have wandered to reconsider their first love. When finished, this project will cost \$250,000 to create and deploy. This is a big investment, but to what lengths will we not go for guiding our children and grandchildren safely home to Jesus? 


