After over 30 years in full-time ministry, I've worked with many organizations, but after being with HASTEN for several years, I can confidently say they are deeply committed to spreading the gospel while providing free health and dental care.

HASTEN was founded in 1985 by Dr. Dennis Pruitt, a West Virginia coal miner's son, WWII Naval aviator, Purple Heart & Distinguished Flying Cross recipient, and missionary surgeon. Since then, HASTEN has expanded to several countries.

In Haiti, Dr. Dan continues to bless many through his medical practice and preaching, despite gang violence and corruption. Dr. Pena is faithfully serving in the Dominican Republic, helping those in need while sharing the gospel. Our church and school in Zimbabwe remain strong, and we continue to maintain influence in Mexico.

Our newest mission is in Colombia, where young doctors and dentists treat many daily, distributing Spanish Testaments to those without a Bible.

Under the leadership of Executive Director Dr. Pete Kunkle, HASTEN has also launched a domestic component—a medical mission trailer, recently serving western North Carolina, providing free dental and medical care to those in desperate need.


