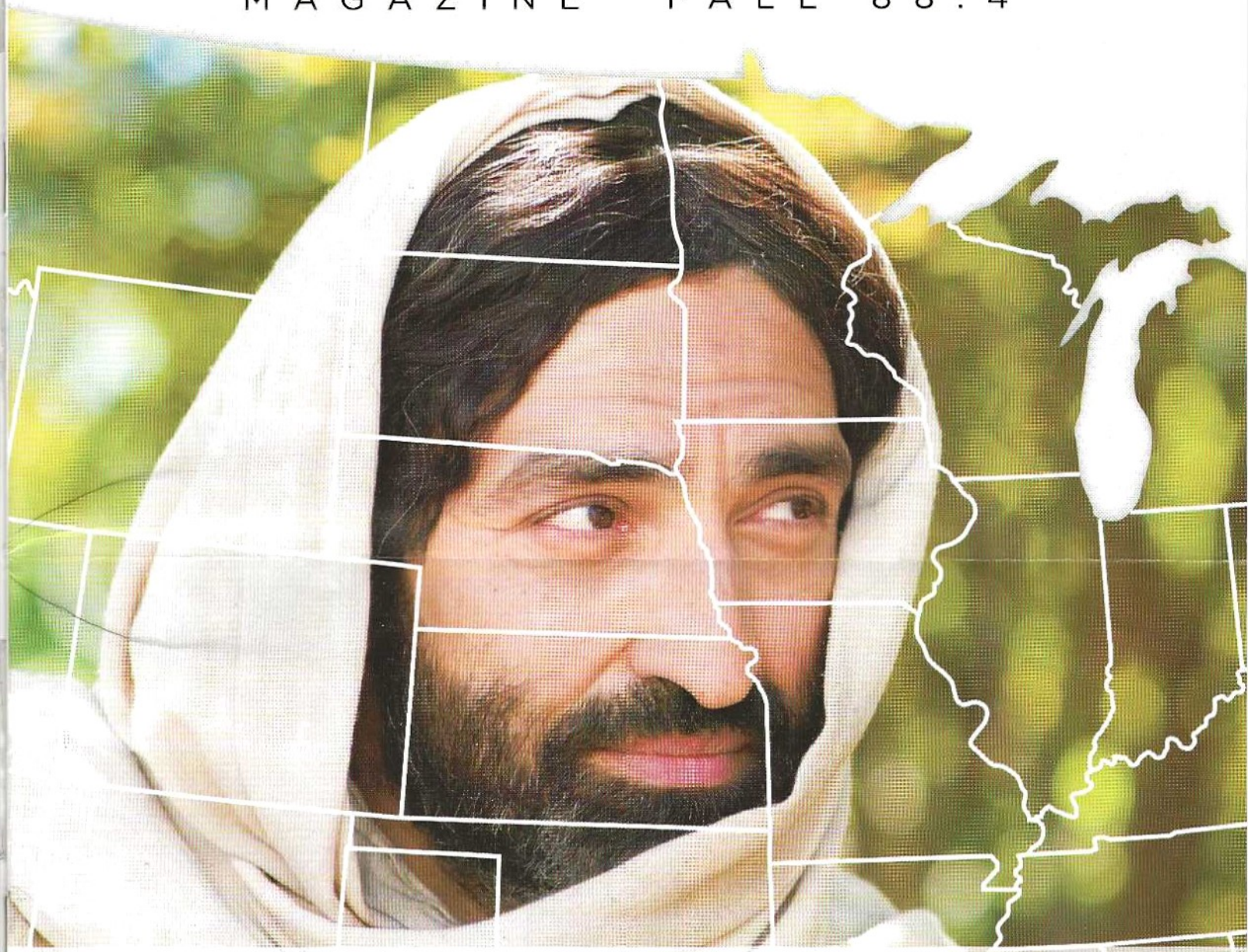

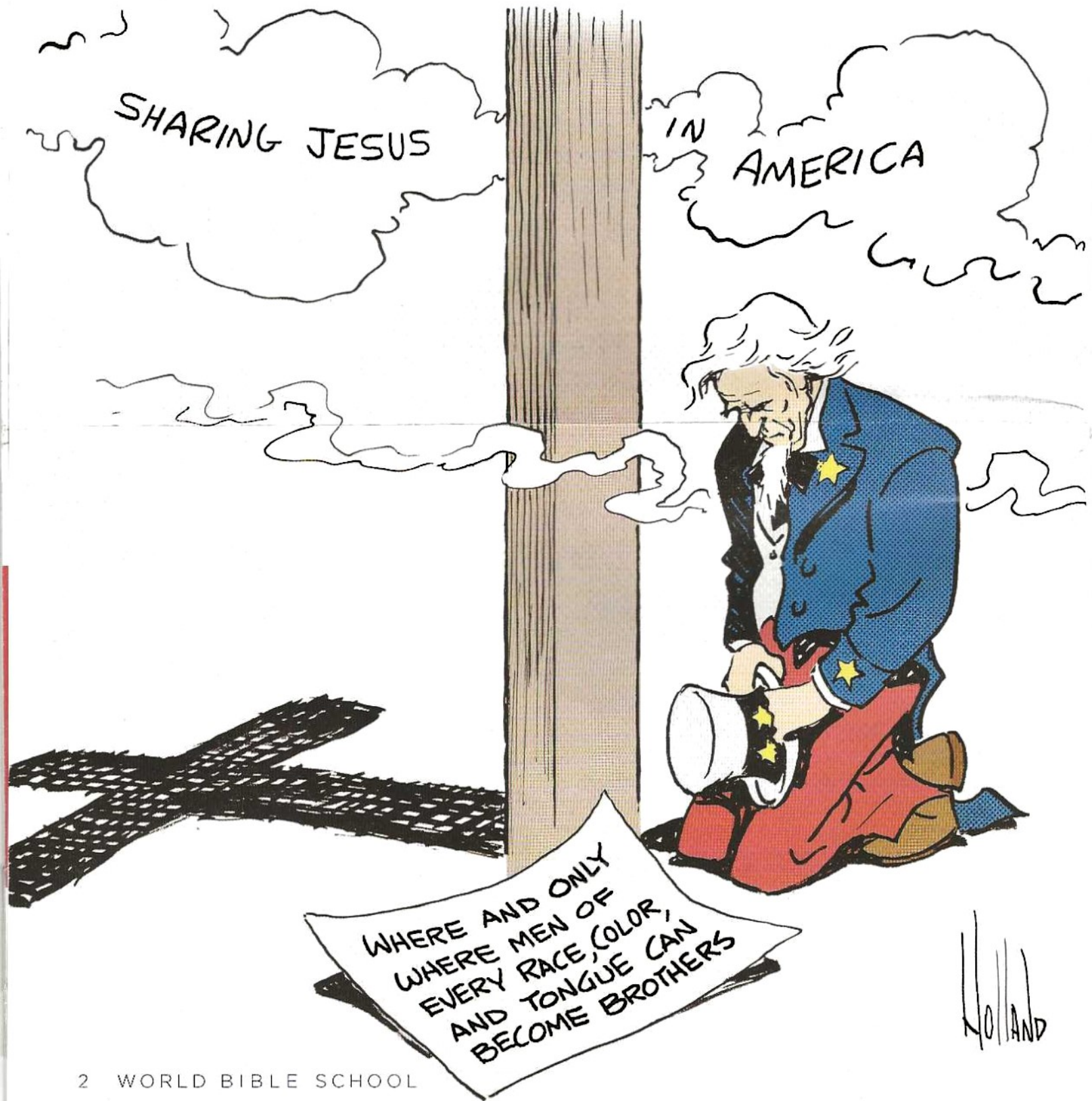

As I was researching previous articles for our 50 Forward Campaign (where we are honoring our first 50 years while looking forward to our next 50 years), I ran across this illustration drawn by Brother Holland in 1968. Holland, a professional illustrator for the Chicago Tribune, often helped Jimmie Lovell illustrate spiritual points in ACTION Magazine. This picture of Uncle Sam kneeling at the cross is a powerful reminder of how much **our world needs Jesus** ... how much **the United States needs Jesus!**

Though World Bible School began with Students from Nigeria and has had a significant impact on the continent of Africa, **WBS tools are now deployed to reach every country on earth.** Our generous donors have made significant investment in tools that span several major languages and generations. Many of our Study Helpers have asked if we are giving adequate attention to tools for evangelizing the United States of America. We at WBS certainly share this concern.

I am reminded of a passage from 1 Timothy 4:1, *"Now the Spirit expressly says that in later times some will depart from the faith by devoting themselves to deceitful spirits and teachings of demons"* (ESV).

The only hope for any nation and any generation is to have the teachings of Jesus shining the light of truth and the hope of the Gospel message into the darkness of Satan's influence.

Christians must daily renew their hope in the Gospel and its power to transform lives in order to face the world in which we live.

We see this encouragement from the Apostle Paul in Romans 1:16, *"For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek."*

Sharing the Good News of Jesus really is the power to make a difference in any nation no matter what the

challenges. We are ambassadors of a higher kingdom, the Kingdom of Christ, and not to any kingdom, nation or party of this world. Ultimately, every knee will bow to Jesus. 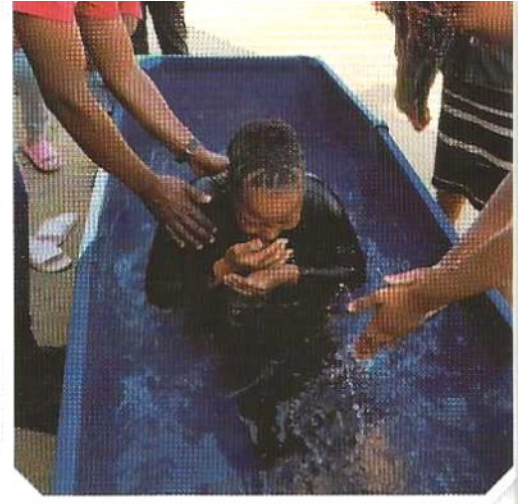

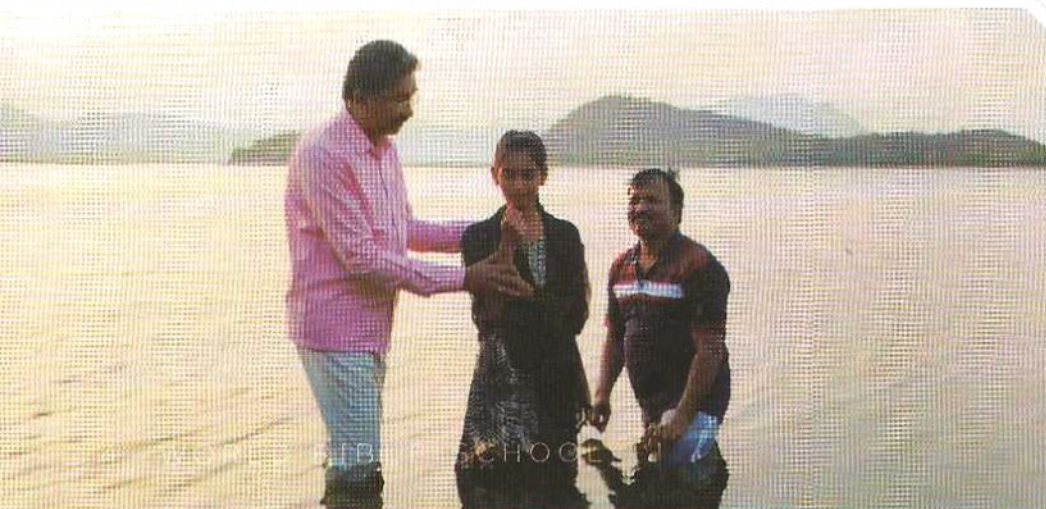
Judith (left) was baptized in a family's pool in San Antonio, Texas. More than a dozen members from the church of Christ came out to witness her act of faith.

Shelby, (right) from Honolulu, Hawaii, studied WBS Online and upon finding the church put on Christ in baptism.

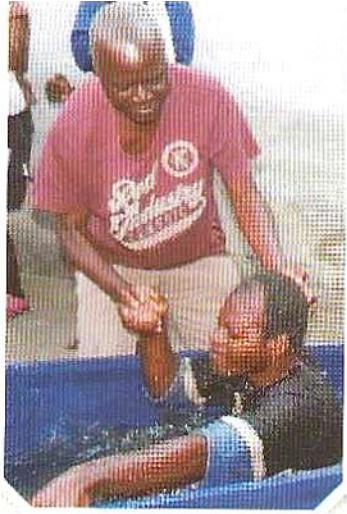


Sadha (left) studied WBS on the WBS App and was baptized into Christ in Andhra Pradesh, India.

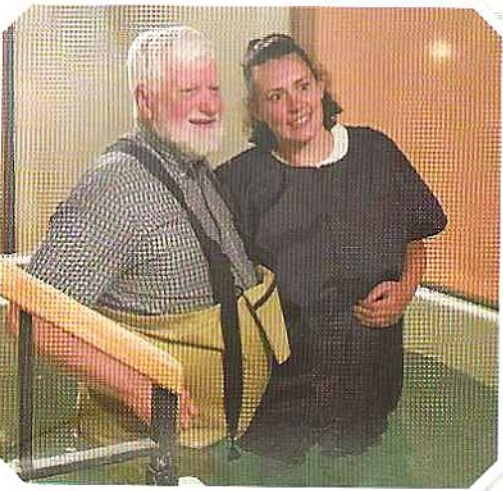

were baptized into Christ despite being in a Zimbabwe prison. They also received their own WBS Study Edition Bible.



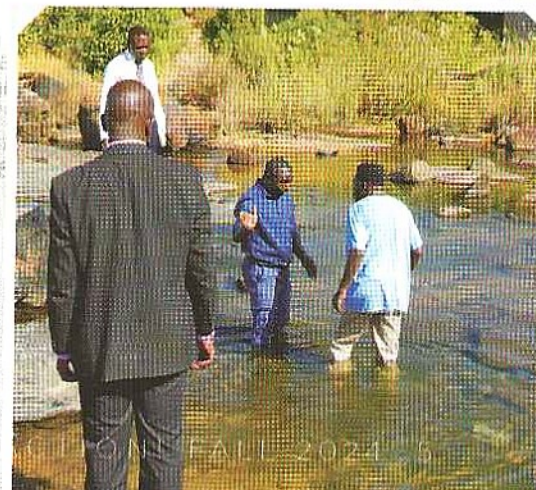
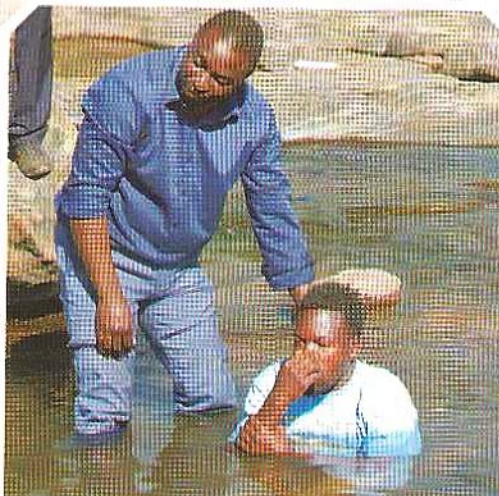
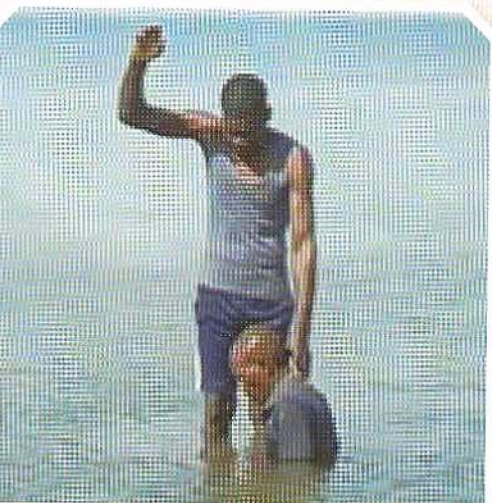
Michaela, (left) from Pueblo, Colorado is baptized and joins local congregation of the Lord's church.

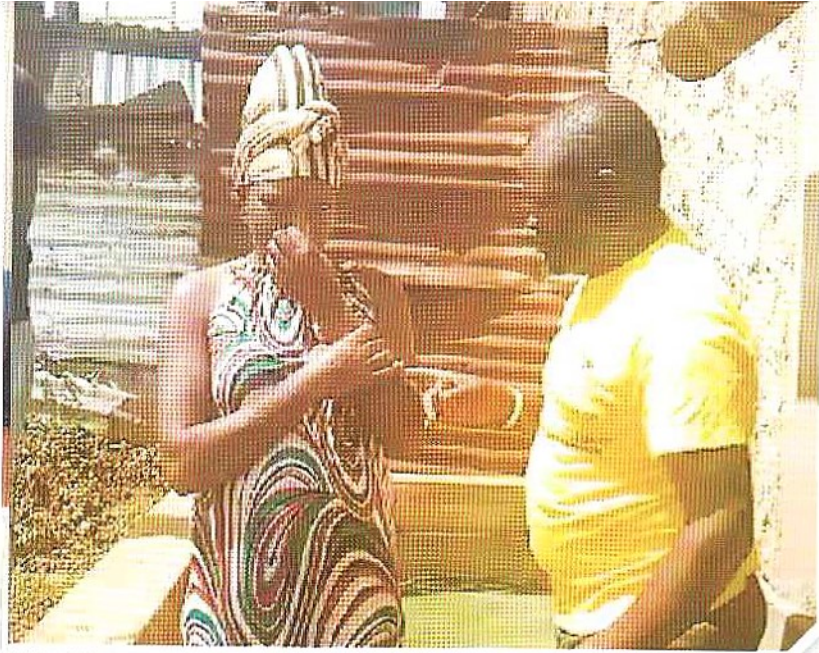

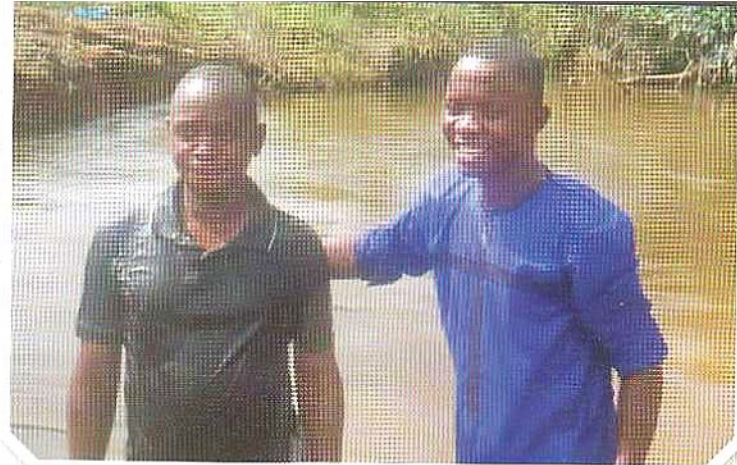
Juap William, (left) a WBS Online Student, from Malawi, continues to conduct local Bible studies which most recently led 87 souls to be baptized into Christ.

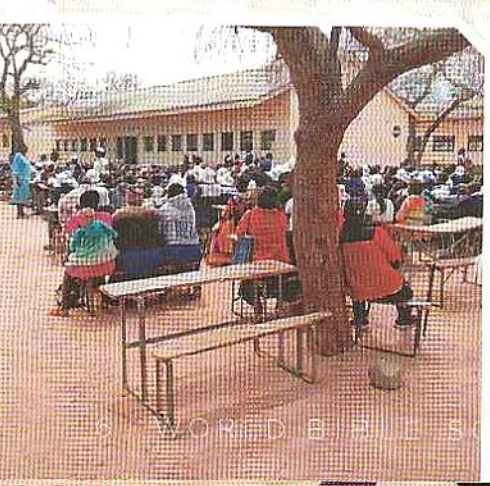

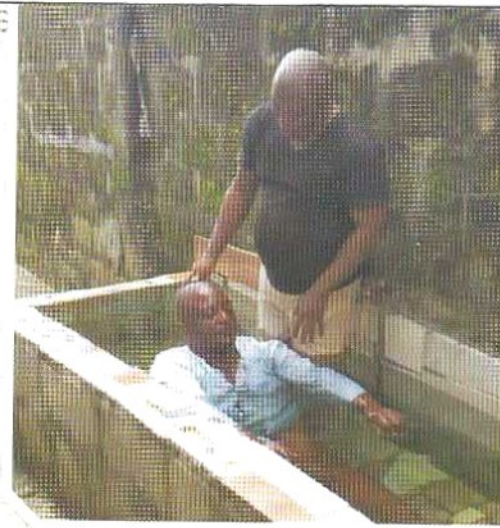

Okongwu, (right) a WBS Lite Student from Sierra Leone was baptized into Christ after completing the Master Series on his smartphone.

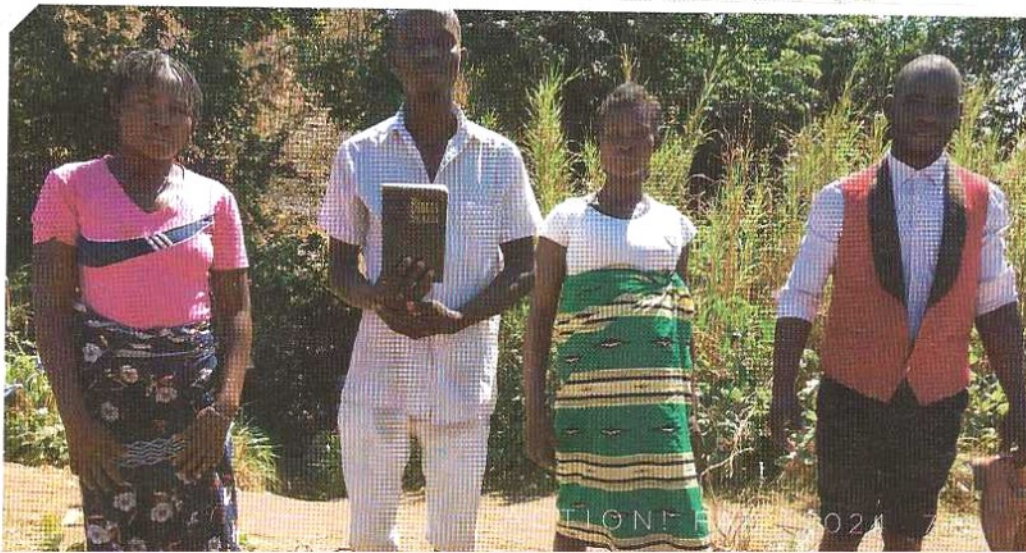

Jesus Must Be Taught: Effective Evangelism

As we focus on Jesus, we see the focus of His concern: “Proclaim the Gospel to the whole creation” (Mark 16:15). The creation He loves now numbers over 8 billion souls, most of whom know nothing of His sacrifice to save them. We pray earnestly to the Lord to *send more laborers into His harvest* (Luke 10:2).

Following Jesus’ focus, World Bible School is determined to accelerate world evangelism. An obvious step is to equip and empower the thousands of Students converted to Christ through WBS. This pool of “laborers” grows significantly every year. Already, many Students enroll their friends and want to do more. For example, veteran missionary, Wendell Broom, conducted regular surveys of churches of Christ in Nigeria. Their church growth doubled every decade, which Wendell attributed to three factors: World Bible School, leadership training schools, and the evangelistic spirit of converts: “They consider their baptism to be their ordination.”

How can such zeal be intensified and made more fruitful? By more purposeful training! You can do so by adding to your curriculum our brand new course, *Effective Evangelism*, as a force multiplier!

In many cases, you know Students who have responded to the Gospel. Wherever they are in the world, if you are still in contact, find a way to send them *Effective Evangelism*. Going forward, treat *Effective Evangelism* as a course that should follow conversion. While the new Christian is excited, build on that enthusiasm for a lifetime of fruitfulness.

Effective Evangelism has a different design for interaction compared to our other Advanced Courses. It has no middle page section to be graded. Instead, it offers three practical assignments whereby the Student applies skills learned in the course.

Like the WBS Advanced Courses, *Effective Evangelism* is designed for much more than correspondence. The 13 interactive lessons are based firmly on the model of Jesus. His principles apply universally in all situations. He fires up motivation. His Word leads to success. This course trains through the Scriptures, offers Bible study sheets and shows Students how to build their own Bible studies for teaching others. Throughout, the focus is on the Lord of the harvest.

Crafting New Ways for

Follow-up

Follow-up has always been a creative partnership between Study Helpers, missionaries, local evangelists and WBS staff. However, the biggest partner in our Follow-up has been God! We never miss an opportunity to pray for our Students as we seek to assist them in being baptized and in finding their place in the body of Christ.

Online Follow-up has been a blessing as we have crafted a digital means of correspondence on our website and smartphone apps. Just like with Postal, we are ever trying to build a network of volunteers who can help. Visit worldbibleschool.net/follow-up learn how you can partner with us to connect Students with the Lord's church.

New tools, like Ocean Bridge, require new methods for Follow-up. The speed of lesson turn-around and the high percentage of Student retention is demanding swifter Follow-up. The time it takes to build this capacity has been challenging in some countries. Congregations such as the Prattville church of Christ in Alabama and the Concord Road church of Christ in Nashville, Tennessee, are helping us craft new effective means to accomplish Follow-up for Ocean Bridge.


Below are some ideas on how we can make our Follow-up even more effective:

- Help us build partnerships with sister ministries who are on-site and on fire for evangelism. Here are a few ministries who are already partnering with us:
 - o Gospel Chariot & Gospel Share Ministries
 - o Sunset International Bible Institute's international schools

- o Southern Africa Bible College
- o Healing Hands International
- o School of the Bible in Brazil

- Ask your Students discerning questions to help them think through their need to be baptized. Many exposed to other beliefs will need to think through their answer carefully.
- Be the persistent widow (Luke 18:1-8) in drawing attention for Follow-up needs to WBS and international volunteers. When we run out of ideas at WBS, pursue creative ways of asking the brotherhood in the specific country to help.
- Involve the Student in their own Follow-up. Some Students may be in schools or prisons that do not allow baptisms. Ask your Student if you can share their contact information with a local evangelist in their area. Try finding a contact or a church near your Student (you can also contact our WBS office for assistance). Share that information with your Student so they can pursue being baptized or finding a church home.
- Patiently and prayerfully persevere. When we have all tried our best, let's ask God to help as we keep teaching more Students. God is the bigger partner and can make a way!

Finally, thank you for all you do to help Follow-up with Students longing for true life in Christ!

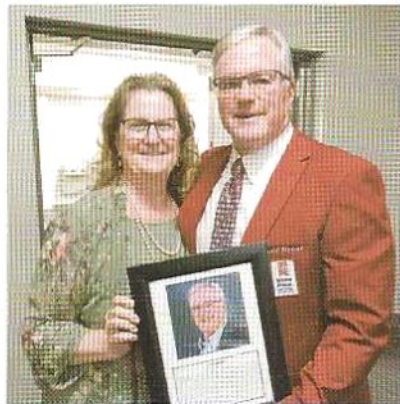
