Day Care and Kindergarten Children



*As part of our Giving Tuesday appeal, we are sharing with you our urgent request for a critical need in North Korea.*

It's been a long time since we've highlighted the country of North Korea, where famine and sickness persist and temperatures drop way below freezing. The children there lack warm winter clothes, and it breaks our hearts.

THOUGH WE ARE UNABLE TO ENTER NORTH KOREA BECAUSE THE COUNTRY IS CLOSED TO EVERYONE, WE ARE ABLE TO SEND FUNDS IN TO HELP WITH THE PROJECTS WE STARTED BACK IN 2001.

To remind our readers, we are the only Christian Church NGO that has ever worked in North Korea. After 20 years, the U.S. government ordered all Americans to stop working inside the country.

C. Y. and I worked very hard to make our presence known in North Korea! "WE ARE HERE TO LOVE YOU AND HELP YOU" was what we said when the officials asked, "Why are you here?" We were responsible for feeding, clothing, and giving medical aid to the people. We established a Bread Factory and built an Orphanage to house children who had no home! We built and operated 3 medical clinics, 2 kindergartens, and 1 day care center. We understood we were the Christian Church missionaries who were there to lay the groundwork as frontier workers. We were there, and are still working behind the scenes, to serve.
