**T**hirteen-year-old Maci grew up with the responsibilities of an adult. She was forced to be a caregiver for herself and 7 younger siblings. She lived in constant fear and stress – worried her siblings would not have their basic needs met.

Life was becoming too much for Maci. She started struggling with suicidal thoughts and became aggressive in school. She refused to listen to authority and started lashing out at those around her.

**You made sure that Maci was safe and cared for. Because of you, she was able to finally be a kid and focus on herself. You have provided her with a healing environment where she discovered her true worth in Christ.**

Maci had difficulty trusting anyone. She would lie, steal and resort to aggressive behaviors. She became suicidal and used substances to cope.

But your generosity has helped change Maci's view of herself and others. After months of building trust, Maci now has healthy coping skills, increased self-esteem and felt safety.

Maci is now a model resident and incredible leader to the other girls. She has been so grateful

## Liam's emotions controlled him You gave him a fresh start

Sixteen-year-old Liam came to us full of grief and anger. Born prematurely and exposed to opiates, he required urgent care from the very beginning. Due to his mother's choices, he was placed in multiple homes and couldn't understand why he was abandoned.

Liam had difficulty controlling his emotions and resorted to anger and violence when faced with difficulty. He struggled communicating his feelings and pushed everyone away.

**But, because of your kindness, Liam found a safe place to stay. He received help and healing from his difficult past. He has learned he is worthy of love!**

Liam has made tremendous progress through equine therapy, especially in building trust and safety within relationships. Initially hesitant around the horses, he soon found that singing helped soothe both himself and the horse. As his confidence grew, so did his ability to understand what he needed and desired from relationships—and how to express those needs in a healthy way.

Liam was recently discharged to his adoptive family and now knows he is safe and has people who care about him. What an amazing gift you have given him! Thank you!



# Trevor believed he was worthless. Because of you, he knows he is loved and valuable!

**E**ight-year-old Trevor has experienced a lot in his short life. Those he should have been able to trust were the sources of trauma and pain. He was abused by his father and did not get the love and care he so desperately craved.

Trevor struggled to understand his trauma. He would experience overwhelming emotions and would start hurting himself to release his pain.

**Because you gave, Trevor received the life-changing care he needed and deserved. He started trauma-informed therapy and learned his needs matter. Trevor's life is better because of you.**

Trevor was behind in several subjects in school. He was told he was stupid and didn't believe he had any worth. Trevor had simply stopped trying.

With your support, Trevor received a safe and stable place to focus on healing from his trauma. He has learned his well-being is worth the work. His progress has been amazing!

# Norah needs stability, care and a safe place to stay this school year!
