Commentary on James and Commentary on 1 Peter

This month's Book Club selection features two books: *Commentary on James* and *Commentary on 1 Peter*, both written in the Khasi language. These works are the result of a new partnership with Cornerstone Bible College in Meghalaya State, located in the far northeastern corner of India. Last month, Khasi became the 101st language of LATM completed projects, with the publication of *The Seven Sayings of Christ on the Cross*. Each of the books are authored by professors from the Bible College.

LATM aims not only to assist church leaders in translating books into their languages but also to *promote Christian literature written by local authors in their native tongues*.

When asked how these commentaries would be utilized, the authors responded:

Bible students and believers will read these books, including those who cannot read English. They will help readers understand the original author's intent and the context of the Bible, enabling them to apply the lessons to their lives in our Khasi culture. Additionally, these commentaries will support teachers in Bible studies, Bible institutes, Sunday schools, and cell churches. Many churches lack any resources to aid their Bible teaching.
