

OPEN DOORS. OPEN HEARTS.



God is opening doors across Ukraine — and through your generosity, hearts are opening too.

When war broke out in February 2022, our Mariupol team had to evacuate. With no destination in mind, they drove away from the frontlines—escaping death and destruction, clinging to God’s direction every single day. God placed them in different regions of Ukraine, scattering a group of faithful Christians.

Does that sound familiar?

In Acts 8, the early church was also scattered—yet the Gospel spread even faster.

“Those who had been scattered preached the word wherever they went” (Acts 8:4).

Just like that, our faithful workers began to minister wherever God had placed them.

They found other believers, formed outreaches, and began serving the displaced, the hurting, and the desperate—sharing both help and hope.



Doors of Opportunity

In those early days, God brought us a new partner: Volodymyr, a young Christian pastor filled with passion for his people and a burning desire to share Christ. We quickly realized that God blessed him with the stamina and drive to propel Mulberry to a different level.

Last year, he established “Because I Believe” - a Ukrainian nonprofit foundation that became Mulberry’s official branch in Ukraine. This opened new doors of opportunity, allowing us to purchase and distribute aid directly for thousands of people in need.

In 2024 alone, we delivered over 1.5 million pounds of aid—food packets, clothing, furniture, even mobile homes for those who lost everything. Fifty new homes now belong to Ukrainians who lost everything due to the war.

A New Door Opens

God is on the move. This year, another unexpected opportunity appeared. David Empson, Executive Director of the International Conference on Missions (ICOM), reached out to our Executive Director, Natasha Reimer, with an incredible offer: to ship a 40-foot container of aid directly to Mulberry in Ukraine.

Because of our new foundation status, we can now receive and distribute this container ourselves. Together with IDES, FAME, and Lifeline, we are collecting winter coats, shoes, bedding, and hygiene items—enough to fill one (maybe two!) containers.

Each shipment carries over 60,000 pounds of hope that will warm bodies and open hearts.

Open Hearts

As we receive this container, our team will distribute aid to the most desperate families, but it's never just about supplies. Each distribution always begins with worship, prayer, followed by the Biblical message and fellowship. We meet families, hear their stories, and begin praying for their salvation.

These Ukrainians are invited to attend church, Bible study group, and join our ministry family. Many return. They bring friends.

This year, we have provided aid to over 2,000 people every month and planted three new churches, with over 200 people attending regularly! One of those churches is actually has been built from ground up, using a construction grant from IDES!
