On November 20-23, a group of adventurous UT and BGSU students travelled for over 10 hours to Atlanta, Georgia, for this year's International Conference on Missions (ICOM). We absolutely love taking students to this conference, so they can meet other mission minded people from around the world and make connections to see what they could do either in the summer or after graduation! This was one of the best ICOMs we have been to (and we've gone for many years). The students and staff were greatly impacted. Here is what students are saying about the trip:
