Dear Friends,

I'm just checking to see if you've had a chance to make a decision about the opportunity I shared in my last letter.

I know you're already into your fall schedule, and you may need some more time. Because of this, we've decided to extend the deadline to respond.

In case you missed my first letter, here's a reminder:
