10 Ways you can help AICM reach the Native American people.

1. Pray for God to open the hearts of the Native American people to gladly receive the gospel message of hope only found in Jesus Christ.
2. Raise awareness of the work God is doing through AICM by sharing with family, friends and your church.
3. Come to serve by bringing a short-term ministry team to AICM over the summer or during the school year.
4. Come to work for us as full-time ministry staff in the school or other areas of need.
5. Purchase items from the "how to help" tab and our department needs on the aicm.org website.
6. Sponsor one of our students in our school for a minimum of \$30 per month.
7. Send funds and Walmart cards to purchase food for the school and student homes. *Arizona churches can hold a food drive for our mission; we have a list of food items needed upon request.*
8. Help with the general budget by making a one-time donation or by becoming a monthly supporter of AICM.
9. Make a contribution from your IRA, other retirement programs or your business to offset tax liabilities.
10. Use your private and corporate tax credits to help with student tuition. Arizona private school tax credits allow taxpayers to receive a dollar-for-dollar reduction on their state income tax liability by donating to a certified School Tuition Organization (STO). The STO's we use are ACSTO, CRLIBS, SCA, and CTSO. Be sure to select our school when donating.

AICM is a nonprofit Christian organization that serves the Navajo, Hopi, and White Mountain Apache Tribes. We are a 501(C)(3) charity, and all donations are tax deductible. All contributions are donations and there are no goods or services provided to donors in return for them. AICM is debt free and operates under a predetermined budget each year.
