Dear Friends in Christ,

We continue to praise God for his abundant blessings throughout 2025. This past year was what may prove to be a watershed year for the University. We publicly launched a \$7 million capital campaign in early June. With over \$5 million of the goal already in hand, we also announced that we had completely paid off all debt at Kentucky Christian University! We are so grateful for generous donors like yourself that God has called to support the University. As of the end of December, we have received in gifts and pledges over 95% of our goal. However, we feel called to do much more than be debt-free. We are also in the process of launching additional degrees in several schools, including the Keeran School of Bible and Ministry. More information about those new programs will be shared later this year.

I hope you have been to campus recently. There are plenty of activities for everyone. 2025 saw the revival of Summer in the Son (SITS) on our campus. You will not want your youth group to miss this year's SITS program on July 12-17. We also hosted the National Bible Bowl Championships this fall along with several other high school student-oriented events. The summer concert series and fall gala continue to draw large crowds. We enjoyed Ricky Skaggs, Josh Baldwin, and the 202nd Army Band of the Kentucky National Guard for a patriotic concert during the Fourth of July Week. We hosted Mark Lowry for our gala and are looking forward to Kirk Cameron on November 7, 2026.

Fall enrollment is up overall 12% from last fall with a total headcount of 616 including dual enrollment. Of even more encouragement is that there are 92 students seeking some type of credential through the Keeran School of Bible and Ministry. This does not include 27 of the 45 students who are in the worship collective who are training to be worship leaders but are earning a degree outside of the Keeran School of Bible and Ministry. While we are pleased with these numbers, please continue to pray that God would send us students to train for ministry from your church.

There have been numerous campus improvements over this past year, made possible through the generosity of donors. We were able to significantly upgrade both the technology and the look of the chapel and we were able to build a 15-bay storage facility for the bass fishing team. We were blessed to replace the front entry sign and, of course, replace a roof or two.
