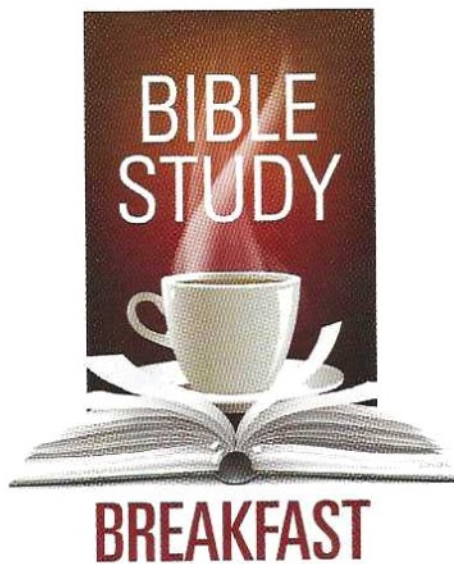
Why SICOM?
