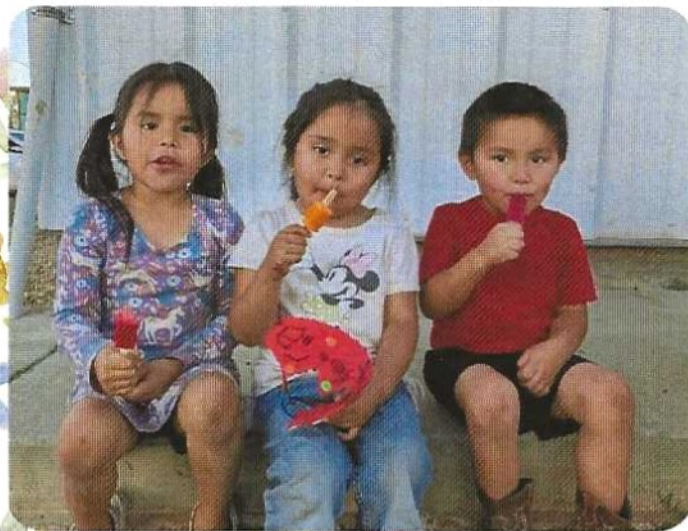
Spring Break!
