COLOMBIA Update from Drs. Daniel & Tannia...



DENTAL:

“Dentistry gives me a practical way to serve people with love, respect, and hope. It is more than treatment. It is listening, showing empathy, and caring for each person as someone who truly matters.

Over time, I came to understand that God led me into dentistry to serve, to heal, and to share His love with others.”

EVANGELISM:

From a young age, I felt called to help people, especially in places where medical care was limited and hard to access. That calling led me to study medicine, and with God’s help, I was able to become a doctor.

Haiti: Amid violence and instability, Dr. Daniel Adolphe has remained in Gonaives to care for people and share the Gospel. Over the past year, 4,766 new patients have come to his small clinic. He asks for prayer for safety, restored order, and the resources needed to meet these great needs.

Dominican Republic:



Dr. Jesús Peña Dumé is a longtime physician and ministry leader who serves alongside his three children

in a medical clinic caring for the poor and underprivileged. On Sundays, the clinic becomes a Christian church for worship, Sunday school, and preaching. He and his wife, Doloris, also host missionaries, oversee outreach ministries and camps, and provide leadership for ministers across the country.
