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It has been several years since we've been able to celebrate the arrival of so many short-term missionaries to serve alongside us! In the past quarter, 135 eager, hard-working servants arrived! They came from Second Church of Christ, Danville, IL, First Christian Church, Yuma, AZ, Veritas Christian Academy, O'Fallon, MO, Partnership Christian Church, Maryville, TN, Eastside Christian Church, Jeffersonville, IN, Faith Christian School, Mesa, AZ, One Life Church, Mesa, AZ and Ball State Christian Campus House, Muncie, IN. We understand that this sounds like way more people than we needed for the projects and plans we're involved in. Rest assured, they were exactly what...and who we needed.

The parsonage has progressed from bare studs to a beautifully painted exterior. The inside has air-conditioning duct work, electrical wiring, insulation, plumbing and most of the drywall installed.

A family of three were planning to move into a home that had been in their family for years. The past several years, other family members had allowed a drug dealer to reside within. Miraculously, his departure was peaceful. We imagined repairing some drywall, and the broken windows. When we were able to enter, what was discovered was far worse than expected. Rains had pushed mud beneath the foundation for a long, long time. The floors needed replaced and leveled. We're now involved in a major renovation there as well.

Our Safe House continues to receive the work Pros can do when not coaching basketball, picking up donated beds and distributing them, caring for his own six children and the teens who are already living with them and more, all with the help of his wife, Roxie. Tiling a shower is a "one-man-job." We're excited as a small team from Eastside Christian Church plans to return this month to help him with some of his larger projects.

Four afternoons each week, our team is teaching, counseling and playing with at least 25 children (a total of over 120 each and every week!) These visiting teams bring the craft and game with them. Watching as kids squeal with delight when they realize a group of visitors has arrived to help, is priceless!

In addition to all of this, these groups also fixed ARM's bridge, a trail at our offices that leads up to an area to pray, organized offices and began the set-up for our annual Backpack Project, painted weathered sheds and more at our own facilities.

AND THEN... a group was on hand so that we could celebrate a Family Fun Day! As always, prayers were lifted for many of them by our team at this event. It was the prayers an Apache grandmother who felt compelled to pray on behalf of our intern, Noah, that warmed our hearts most. The crowd was huge, the fun and laughter contagious as 250 bean burritos, chips and fruit, popcorn, cotton candy, and snow cones were shared with all in attendance.

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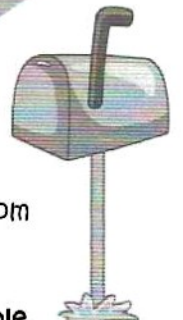
