An Incredible Evening

Alliance Pregnancy Center's annual banquet and silent auction, held on May 14, 2026, at the University of Mount Union Hoover-Price Campus Center, was a beautiful evening centered around this year's theme, "Continue to Love," from 1 John 4:7. The banquet was sold out, with more than 200 guests in attendance, and served as a wonderful reminder of God's faithfulness through the ministry of APC.

Guests were welcomed with a wide variety of silent auction items, hors d'oeuvres, and beautifully decorated tables lined with candles and rose petals. Throughout the evening, there was a special sense of unity and encouragement as friends reconnected, new friendships were formed, and supporters gathered together to celebrate all that God has done through APC over the past year.

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An Incredible Evening continued...

During dinner, APC staff shared 2025 ministry statistics, stories of patient and client interactions, testimonies of how the Lord is working through the center, and visions for the future of the ministry. A skit performed by staff members highlighted the impact APC has had on moms, dads, and families, encouraging and equipping them to choose life and grow stronger in their parenting journeys.

The evening's guest speaker, Keith Ferrin, delivered a powerful and unique presentation by reciting the book of Philippians entirely from memory. Guests were encouraged not to follow along in their Bibles, but simply to listen to Paul's words as the Philippian church would have originally heard them.

During his presentation, Keith challenged attendees with three specific ways to pray for APC: first, to pray with joy whenever APC comes to mind; second, to pray for unity as the ministry serves the community; and third, to pray that APC would have discernment and wisdom from God in every situation, so that the staff and volunteers can continue being the hands and feet of Jesus to those who walk through the center's doors. His presentation beautifully highlighted the partnership and incredibly important role that supporters play through their prayers for APC.

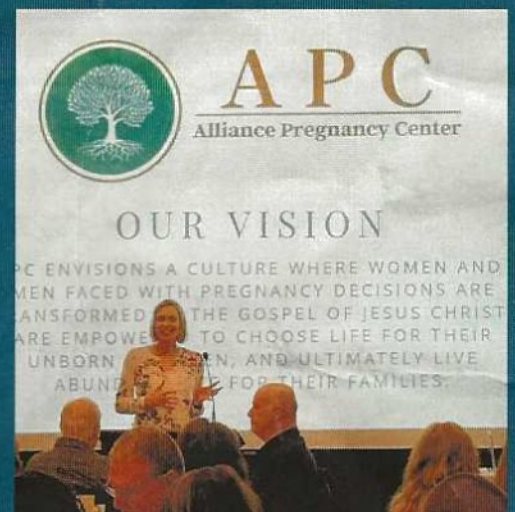
